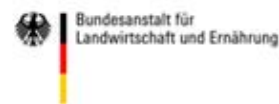

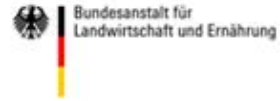
Conclusions of the Conference and next steps

- After publication, COM may develop an action plan and a roadmap to follow-up.
- The Preparatory Action continues as a **Second study** has been launched early 2016 with the aim to foster the use of neglected agricultural GRs (animals and plants). It intends to provide different categories of stakeholders with concrete examples to valorise the use of neglected breeds and varieties in an economically viable way.
